Just imagine if each Scout or Scout family invited and brought in just one new Scout this fall, think where our membership would be! What kind of impact could we make in our schools and community through Scouting? Make an “ask!”

Is your unit ready for the 2016-2017 Scouting Year? Did you take advantage of the suggested steps in the past two editions of the Scouting News to prepare for the fall program? Cub packs, have you scheduled your Join Scouting Night (JSN)? Do you need help? If so, contact your commissioner, district commissioner or your District Executive for help. Now is the time to recruit your new Scouts and leaders. To assist in your recruitment along with asking your district for help. This year, all new Cub Scouts registered in the office by September 30th will receive a “Rocket”. So tell your Cub Scouts to bring a friend to the meeting.

Below are steps that a unit, in particular a pack, should complete:

1. Conduct a Leader’s Analysis.
2. Identify your Tiger leaders and help them log-on to on-line training.
3. Build your calendar and budget. Have copies to share with new Scout families.
4. Set your Join Scouting Night (JSN) no matter the type of unit. Packs, try to hold before September 23, 2016.
5. Create a handout with a brief biography on all the unit’s leadership. If possible, have a picture of them.
6. Troops, Crews don’t be left out of the recruiting. Make Scouting the thing to do in your community.
7. Exploring Posts, let’s give High School students an opportunity to explore career fields by inviting them to join Exploring.

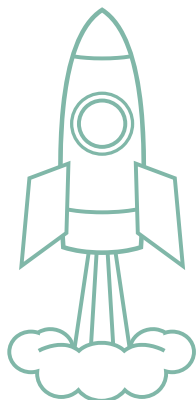
