Cost is \$6 per Scout, which includes patches & tape & awards & program support.

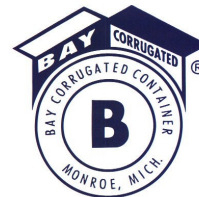

DESIGN & CONSTRUCT A BUILDING

This division is open to both 4th & 5th grade Webelos & Arrow of Light Scouts, and requires Scouts to build structures on 10'x10' plot with cardboard, tape, and tools after the permitting process.

Division is limited to 4th & 5th grade Webelos & Arrow of Light Scouts, with 4-5 Scouts per plot.

On the date(s) you select (November 14-22), your Den will complete the orientation, permitting, and construction of the building you select. We always recommend your Den to use meetings before the event to plan your work and even practice with a model. Creativity is always encouraged!

DESIGN & CONSTRUCT A BRIDGE

This division is open to only 5th grade Arrow of Light Scouts, and requires Scouts to build a bridge spanning 12' with cardboard, tape, and tools after permitting process. This division is limited to 5th grade Arrow of Light Scouts.

On the date(s) you select (November 14-22), your Den will complete the orientation, permitting, and construction of the bridge. We always recommend your Den to use meetings before the event to plan your work and even practice with a model. Creativity is always encouraged!
