## Camp Frontier at Pioneer Scout Reservation Celebrating 50 Camping Seasons!

Pioneer Scout Reservation (PSR) was created with the land purchase in 1964 but not formally named until 1967 and later dedicated on June 28, 1970. The original plan called for the creation of five separate Boy Scout camps all located at Pioneer Scout Reservation. Each would have had their own facilities and programs. To date, the only camp developed has been Camp Frontier.

Camp Frontier was opened in 1969. The first winter camping began in early 1969, and the first weekly Boy Scout Summer Camp sessions were conducted that summer with Gary Lehman serving as the first Camp Frontier Director.

This year **Camp Frontier is celebrating its 50th Camping Season!** We have several activities planned for this year to celebrate so stay tuned for more information!

## Arrow of Light (2nd year Webelos) to Scout Transition

Pack leadership should make sure Arrow of Light Scouts (2nd year Webelos) and their parents visit area Troops to see which Troop is the best fit for the Scout and family to join. Troops should contact Packs to invite the Arrow of Light Scouts to visit your Troop. Arrow of Light Scouts should be crossed over by March, so Scouts and their parents have time to prepare for summer camp, the highlight of the Scouting year. Let's make this the best year ever on Arrow of Light Scouts crossing over to Boy Scouts!

Troop leaders, make sure the Scout application is turned in, in a timely manner.

## Rechartering

Just a reminder! All January charters are now due to Karen, Council Registrar, at the Jadel Leadership Center Council office. **Completed Charters are due by Monday, January 15.** Remember completed means all registered leaders are current on YPT (Youth Protection Training), correct signatures are on the cover page of the charter and the registration fees are paid. Karen will need time to process over 200 Charters by January 30. If you need help, contact your Commissioner, District Professional or Karen. **Charters not in and processed by Wednesday, January 31 will drop on February 1, 2017 per National guidelines.** Those dropped will need to turn in all new paperwork.

As a reminder to Packs, Arrow of Light Scouts should be rechartered on your Pack Charter. When the Scout joins a Troop, he will fill out a transfer application and there is no registration or transfer fee to pay.
