University of Toledo Scholarship for Boy Scouts

The Boy Scout Law notes, among other things, that Scouters are trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, and kind. Barry and Mary Jo Bellner Swartzberg believe those traits are deserving of a college scholarship.

The Swartzbergs recently established **The Ted Swartzberg and Paul Bellner Scholarship Fund** at The University of Toledo, where they are both alumni. The new scholarship will benefit needy and deserving UT students who are Boy Scouts, with priority given to Eagle Scouts. The first awards will be made for the 2020-2021 academic year.

“Scouting builds character,” said Mr. Swartzberg. “A nationwide survey in 2012 demonstrated the significant,

positive impact Eagle Scouts have on society, from holding leadership positions in their workplace and neighborhood to volunteering to protect the environment and being prepared for emergencies,” said Mr. Swartzberg. “It is a proven fact that Scouting produces better citizens and builds character in young men.”

This spring there were 284 Arrow of Light Scouts (5th Grade Webelos) ready to join a Boy Scout Troop! Don't wait! If they have not crossed over yet, now is the time. A Scout who attends summer camp is more likely to stay in Scouting than a Scout who has not had the camping experience. Graduate those Webelos into Boy Scouts and let them enjoy a camping adventure now! Troop leadership, don't forget to turn in the new Scout application to transfer the Scout to your troop. There is no transfer fee!

Advance Planning for a Successful Fall Scouting Program

Unit committees, before you break for summer, take steps now to help your unit have a successful fall program:

- 1. Leadership analysis** – Recruit parents now to fill vacant positions and get them trained.
- 2. Lions Leaders** – Recruit an experienced leader to guide the parents as they take turns being the leader for the den.
- 3. Tiger Leaders** – See if an existing leader is willing to be the Tiger leader or to be a mentor to the new one.
- 4. Build your unit calendar and budget** – Create a one-page calendar handout with dates and activities to distribute to new parents and Scouts at the Join Scouting Night.
- 5. Erie Shores Council Join Scouting Night – Thursday, September 6** is a one-night marketing/recruitment blitz for new scouts. See your District Executive or Commissioner for details and support.
- 6. Family Scouting** – For those packs welcoming girls, remember you will need a separate den and separate den leaders. For more details on girls joining Cub Scouting go to ErieShoresCouncil.org/familyscouting.
