## Get Ready to Get “Hooked on Scouting”

September 6, 2018 Council Wide Join Scouting Night



September is “**Hooked on Scouting**” month! Now is the time to encourage your Scouts to invite a friend to your units’ Join Scouting Night (JSN). On **September 6, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.**, Scouting volunteers will be available at elementary schools throughout our council to meet families interested in joining Scouting.

We are urging all units to use this date as their unit’s Join Scouting Night. With one date, the council wide promotion will be more effective on helping all units reach families in their area. Please have someone available at your school on September 6th even if your unit is planning a JSN on a different night.

### Is your “Be A Scout” Updated?

All units should update their “Be a Scout” unit pin on My.Scouting.org. With the introduction of Family Scouting, it is very important for this to be up to date. This will help guide families with interested girls to find a pack. Even if your pack is choosing to remain “all boy”, updated “Be a Scout” pins will also help unit leaders guide interested parents of girls to other packs nearby.

### Is Your Unit Ready for Some Scouting?

Is your unit ready for the 2018-2019 Scouting Year? Do you have your program calendar planned? Cub packs, have you scheduled your Join Scouting Night (JSN)? Do you need help? If so, contact your unit commissioner, district commissioner or your District Executive for help. Now is the time to recruit your new Scouts and leaders.

### Below are steps that a unit, in particular a pack, should complete:

1. Conduct a Leader’s Analysis.
2. Identify your Lion and Tiger leaders and help them log-on to online training.
3. Build your calendar and budget. Have copies to share with new Scout families.
4. Do you have coverage for the September 6th Join Scouting Night?
5. Create a handout with a brief biography and photo on all the unit’s leadership. New parents like putting a face to the name and knowing who will be leading their child.

We are so excited that Lions are an official rank of the Cub Scout Program. This year all packs should be prepared to welcome Kindergarten youth into their pack. The Lion Guide role from the pilot program will now be a registered Den Leader. If you have questions on Lions, contact your Commissioner or District Executive.

Today all of us are spending more time than ever using digital media for education, research, socializing, and fun. Keeping safe online has become more important than ever. To help families and volunteers keep youth safe while online, the Boy Scouts of America introduced the Cyber Chip. In developing this tool, the BSA teamed up with content expert NetSmartz<sup>®</sup>, part of the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children<sup>®</sup> and training expert for many law enforcement agencies.

The Cyber Chip can be used as a tool to show skill and a commitment to do what's right in the cyberworld. Many unit leaders use the Cyber Chip before allowing any electronic use on outings—this is a decision each unit can make on its own. ## MUSEUM FUN FACT

The earliest known Toledo Council "good turn" (performing an act of service) took place in 1913 during the Great Ohio Floods of 1913. It was noted in the June 1913 issue of Boys Life that Toledo Boy Scouts gathered money, food and clothing for flood victims in Dayton, Ohio. Also, in 1913, Dan Beard, one of the founders of the BSA, visited the Toledo Council. The museum at Camp Miakonda has on display the only known surviving program from his visit.
