## Online Recruitment Resources for Units

With COVID-19, recruitment season is going to look a little different this year. We know access to the schools is going to be limited and many events are going to be digital versus face-to-face.

The Erie Shores Council Membership Team wants to make sure that all our units have what they need to recruit new Scouts successfully and safely.

Here you will be able to find the 2020 leaders guide to recruitment, pre-made PowerPoint presentations to use during a Join Scouting Night (either in person or virtually), innovative ways to hold a Join Scouting Night in our current climate, videos to market and advertise joining Scouts, and even pre-recorded Scout talks.

Don't worry, we still have the same materials available for print upon request. Request flyers and other printed materials through your district professional. Yard signs, posters, and bookmarks are also available upon request.

## Why is updating your BeAScout Pin so important?

We live in a society of convenience. Everything we need is at our fingertips. Want to order food from your favorite restaurant? With a few clicks online you can have it delivered to your door. Need to go grocery shopping? Pick out your groceries from the convenience of your couch while drinking your morning coffee and have them ready for pick up in the afternoon.

Digital technology helps us manage and juggle our lives every day. Today's parents not only expect things to be online, they almost demand it. Why would we want Scouting to be any different?

When an interested family is looking for a Cub Scout pack in their area they might go online and say "find Cub Scouts near me" or "how do I join Cub Scouts?". The first thing that's going to pop up for them is BeAScout.org. Once they type in their Zip Code, it will pull up the Cub Scout packs closest to them. Having your BeAScout Pin up to date makes it easy for them to find and join your pack.

Not only do you want your contact information up to date, but we strongly encourage you to turn on the online applications as well. It makes the application process easy and streamlined, and they pay National registration dues at that time.

If your pack collects additional pack dues at registration, you can personalize your pin to update the family on what additional dues they can expect to pay at the first meeting. This way there are no surprises.

Once a family completes the registration process, the national office of the Boy Scouts of America will send a welcome packet to that family via email. Through your pin administration, you can also choose to have a personalized welcome letter come directly from the pack.

You will receive email notification when a new family fills out an application and joins. Your new families are registered right away, saving you time and also giving them a great first experience in Scouting.

## MUSEUM FUN FACT

The Silver Fawn Award was the female version of the council-level Silver Beaver Award and it was presented from 1971 to 1974. It was approved for “outstanding service by lady Scouters.” The requirements were the same as the Silver Beaver Award, which at the time was just for male Scouters. The Silver Fawn was discontinued in 1974, when women became eligible to earn the Silver Beaver.

Eight women were the recipients of the Silver Fawn in Erie Shores Council from 1972-1974.

- **Safeguard personal information.** Do not publicly post rosters or personal information of Scouts.

- **Collecting personal information** directly from youth under 13 is not recommended.
