JSN Checklist - Are You Prepared?

You only get one first impression in front of new families at a Join Scouting Night. Don't forget these critical steps to success!

1. Fill out the pack leadership bio and calendar. Make sure to have enough copies of each for all new families.
2. Update your BeAScout pin, using my.scouting.org. Be sure to state if your unit will be participating in Family Scouting, Boy Only, or Girl Only.
3. Make sure you have the right volunteers secured to attend your school JSN on September 12th as pack representatives. The best volunteers make the best first impression!
4. If your unit is not participating in Family Scouting, please have the contact information available of the nearest unit that is, so a family can join if desired.

Congratulations on all of your hard work! You now have new Scouts and families ready to start their adventure. But, have you turned in their applications to the Scout office yet? It is a busy time and sometimes we do not always rush to get the applications turned in. We want to make sure new Scouts are officially registered as soon as possible.
