JSN Checklist - Are You Prepared?

Next week is the big night! The September 6th Join Scouting Night!

Follow this check-list to make sure you are on track for success:

1. Confirm with your district executive the correct information for flyers to be printed. Or alternatively, use the flyer request form here: www.erieshorescouncil.org/flyerrequest
2. Fill out the pack leadership bio and calendar before the first open house and Join Scouting Night. Submit a copy to your District Executive if you wish to have copies made by Council.
3. Do a yard sign blitz in your neighborhood and community. Yard signs can be found at the Jadel Leadership Center.
4. Hang flyers/posters in popular community locations to advertise your pack. Libraries, coffee shops, post offices, cafes/restaurants are some great starting points.
5. Update your BeAScout pin, using my.scouting.org.
6. Schedule a School Talk at your elementary, to get the kids excited about joining.
7. Make sure you have the right volunteers secured to attend your school JSN on September 6th as pack representatives. If you need help filling that role, please contact your district executive.
