## BSA Safety Moment: Hammock Camping

Camping in hammocks has gained in popularity over the past 10 years. More camping equipment manufacturers are offering hammock-style tents as a way of reducing the “footprint” on the camping area. This is helpful from a Leave No Trace standpoint. However, hammocks are not without their risks.

- Follow instructions for hanging.
- Hang hammocks in secure locations, such as to trees or solid posts.
- Securely fasten and check all knots prior to getting into a hammock.
- Never “stack” hammocks one above another.
- Hammocks should not be hung more than 3 feet above the ground.
- Do not hang a hammock above any water source.

- Never swing or stand in a hammock.
- Do not use a hammock that has frayed or damaged ropes.
- Do not put more weight into a hammock than recommended.
- Small children should be supervised when using a hammock.

If you are using solid, living trees, special care should be taken not to damage the outer bark. Some hammock-tents have wide bands of material help to spread out the stress of the hammock-tent.

## MUSEUM FUN FACT

### Eagle Scouts

The Eagle Scout Rank is the highest rank attainable in the Scouts BSA program in the Boy Scouts of America.

The very first Eagle Scout in Council history was Earl Dryfoose who received the award in 1916. Earl attended Purdue University, then later moved to Illinois where he became a State Highway Engineer.

Erie Shores Council has awarded the Eagle Scout Rank to over 7,189 Scouts since 1916.
