BSA Safety Moment: Aquatics Safety

Since the inception of Scouting, learning to swim and engaging in aquatics activities have been core to the program. More than 1.5 million aquatics-related merit badges have been earned by Scouts BSA since 2009. The BSA has also been a leader in promoting and providing training in aquatics safety.

All leaders are encouraged to take the two key training courses: **Safe Swim Defense** and **Safety Afloat**. At least one adult needs the training when unit aquatics activities are conducted.

Both courses can be found on my.Scouting.org and taken online anytime. These are not learn-to-swim or learn-to-paddle courses; they are the BSA way to conduct a safe and fun aquatics program.

2021 BSA National Membership Fee Increase

To ensure we have the resources to fulfill the promise of Scouting, effective **August 1, 2021**, the updated national membership fee is

- \$72 for Youth participants
- \$45 for Exploring participants
- \$45 for all adult volunteers
- \$75 for a unit charter fee
- \$25 one-time joining fee for *new* program participants in Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, and Venturing.

This amount goes directly to the National BSA and does not include any additional fees a Unit may collect.

Across the country and in each of our communities, we know that Scouting remains one of the most valuable investments we can make in young men and women today so they can become the leaders we will turn to tomorrow.

National Youth Leadership Training – History in the Making

Erie Shores Council hosted our first National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) course in 2009 under the direction of Dick "Pops" Ball, Course Director; Theresa (Heyse) Doremus, Scoutmaster, and Wil Merkes, Senior Patrol Leader. The Howling Wolf patrol, NYLT youth and adult staff, welcomed 31 participants on June 14, 2009, representing 11 troops in the council for the inaugural course.

For the past 13 years, Erie Shores Council has run NYLT as planned with the exception of 2020 due to COVID-19 restrictions. The vision of Dick and Theresa has been fully fulfilled in the 2021 course with a full 48 participants and a waiting list with additional Scouts wishing to attend. More than 400 youth leaders have benefited from the leadership skills taught by NYLT at Camp Miakonda.
