## Is Your Unit Ready for Some Scouting?

Is your unit ready for the 2021-2022 Scouting year? Do you have your program calendar planned? Cub Scout Packs, have you scheduled your Join Scouting Night (JSN)? Do you need help?

Below are steps that a unit, in particular a Pack, should complete:

1. Conduct a Leader's Analysis.
2. Identify your Lion and Tiger leaders and help them log on to online training.
3. Build your calendar and budget. Have copies to share with new Scout families.
4. Do you have coverage for Join Scouting Night?
5. Create a handout with a brief biography on all the unit's leadership. Add a photo so new parents can put a face to the name and know who will be leading their child.

## BeAScout.org Pin

### Why is updating your BeAScout.org pin so important?

We live in a world dominated by digital technology. When parents are looking to find activities for their kids, the first place they look is online. Having your BeAScout pin updated allows parents to quickly find your Pack.

### How to update your BeAScout.org Pin.

1. Go to [My.Scouting.org](http://My.Scouting.org). (Unit leaders have access.)
2. In the drop-down menu, select your unit, then Organization Manager.
3. Select Unit Pin on the left-hand side.
4. Update information and click save at the bottom.

### My pin is updated; now what?

Now that your pin is updated, make sure you are checking for new leads. New leads are coming in every day for interested families. Once families request more information, they will be eager for a response. We suggest waiting no more than 24-48 hours to respond. A smooth and great first experience in Scouting will make families excited to join your Pack.

## BSA Safety Moment: Distracted Driving

**D**istracted driving is considered “any activity that diverts the driver's attention away from driving” and can have deadly consequences. The distractions can include a wide range of a driver's or passenger's personal actions or activities while in a vehicle. Even if a driver is only trying to keep Scouts in their seats while the vehicle is in motion, that is a distraction.

### Preventing Distractions

- Put mobile devices away, so you won't be tempted to look at or answer them.
- Turn mobile devices to “silent” or “off.”
- Only check texts and messages during rest stops or food breaks.
- Pull off the road to a safe location if you must use the phone.
- Do not call or send messages while you are driving.

Be the example and tell others that you are choosing to drive, or help others drive, safely and not put lives at risk.
