## Annual Recharter

A reminder that the annual recharter is due for all January units to Michael Smith, Council Registrar/District Assistant, at the Jadel Leadership Center Council office by Monday, January 17, 2022.

A complete recharter includes:

- Current Youth Protection Training for all registered adults.
- Correct signatures completed with Adobe Sign upon completion of the recharter online.
- Signed Annual Charter Agreement.
- Registration Fees and Unit Charter Fee paid.

Current registration fees are:

- **\$72** for Youth Members in Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, and Venturing
- **\$45** for Youth Members in Exploring
- **\$45** for Adult Members in all programs
- **\$25** one-time fee for New Youth Members only
- **\$75** for Unit Charter Fee

Cub Scout Packs should recharter Arrow of Light Scouts on your Pack's charter. When the Scouts crossover to their chosen Troop, a transfer application will be completed by hard copy or online if the Troop supports online registration.

## BSA Safety Moment: Winter Activity Safety

There is magic to camping in winter. It is one of the most challenging outdoor adventures. However, potentially extreme weather conditions, cold temperatures, and unique hazards associated with outdoor winter activities require careful planning to ensure safety. Use the "C-O-L-D" method to stay warm.

**C=Clean:** Keep your insulating layers clean and fluffy.

**O=Overheating:** Avoid overheating by adjusting the layers of your clothing.

**L=Loose layers:** Wear several loosely fitting layers of clothing.

**D=Dry:** Keep dry by avoiding clothes that absorb moisture.

Erie Shores Council, Boy Scouts of America, maintains a Scouting memorabilia museum with collections that date back to 1910.

The Museum is housed in two locations at Camp Miakonda: the Front Museum is inside the Jadel Leadership Center and the Back Museum is in the original building located in the camp.

The Back Museum is the oldest standing Boy Scouts of America camp building outside of England!
