The Boy Scouts of America has partnered with subject-matter experts from the Barbara Sinatra Children's Center Foundation to present the **Personal Safety Awareness Series**.

The Personal Safety Awareness Series' main goal is to educate teens about what to do if they experience abusive behavior, educate them about safe and unsafe touches, and encourage them to go to a parent or another trusted adult for help.

These Personal Safety Awareness videos may be used in place of the Cyber Chip requirement for the Scout and Star ranks. If used in place of the Cyber Chip requirement for a rank, Scouts are encouraged to inform their Parent or Guardian and unit leader of the replacement prior to viewing the videos.

BSA Safety Moment: SAFE Scouting



Scouts and their parents expect all Boy Scouts of America activities to be conducted safely. To ensure the safety of participants, the Boy Scouts of America expects leaders to use the four points of **SAFE** when delivering the Scouting program.

S = Supervision

Scouting policies like two-deep leadership and the buddy system safeguard against incidents.

A = Assessment

Understanding and following the guidelines contained in program materials and the Guide to Safe Scouting helps keep all youth safer in our programs.

F = Fitness and Skill

Fitness is an aim of Scouting. Knowing who can and should participate in a particular activity — by having the necessary fitness and skill to do so — keeps youth and adults SAFE.

E = Equipment and Environment

"Be Prepared" is not just a motto but a method to follow to be safe. Using the right equipment for the right activity and in the proper location keeps Scouting SAFE.
