You will be considered a Trained Leader when you complete the following:

- Youth Protection Training
- Cub Leader Specific Training

Cub Leader Specific (See Calendar)

This training is required for all Cubmasters, Committee Members & Den Leaders. All positions will be trained at The Jadel Leadership Center at Camp Miakonda.

Leave No Trace Trainer Course

LNT (Sept. 16-18, 2016)

This course is open to anyone who has an interest in helping to lessen the impact we have on our outdoors – Adult Leaders, Scouts, Venturers, and Non-Scouters. This course will introduce you to the principles of Leave No Trace. We will teach you the Leave No Trace principals and how to apply them and teach them to others. Minimum age 14

University of Scouting (Nov. 5, 2016)

Informative (and FUN) day of required, supplemental and advanced training for adult and youth leaders involved with Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Sea Scouts and Venturing Programs.

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation

BALOO (Mar. 4, 2017)

This Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation training is required for at least one leader in the Pack in order to conduct outdoor activities. This all-day, hands-on training will provide you with the basics of what you need to know. Training to be held at Camp Miakonda.

Outdoor Webelos Leader Skills

OWLS (Mar. 24-25, 2017)

This training is held in conjunction with Intro to Outdoor Leader Skills for Boy Scouts. Leaders completing this training will be trained for both Courses. While this is not required training, it is highly recommended for those Webelos Leaders wanting to take their Den camping.

Train-the-Trainer Series

Fundamentals of Training (April 8, 2017)

Required training for ALL Erie Shores Training Volunteers, unless currently EDGE trained.

Training is intended for both youth and adult trainers. This 4 hr. session is designed to introduce new Scouting trainers to teaching techniques and skills.

Train-the-Trainer Series

Trainers EDGE (May 13, 2017)

Required training for all Erie Shores Training Event Coordinators and Wood Badge, NYLT & Summer Camp Staff. This 8 hr. course is intended to "train the trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media.

Advisor Key

Award can be earned with 3 yrs. service as a registered Venture Crew Advisor.

Award can be earned with 3 yrs. service as a registered Sea Scout Skipper.
