## Upcoming Events

### Cub Leader Specific (See Calendar)

This training is required for all Cubmasters, Committee Members & Den Leaders. All positions will be trained at The Jadel Leadership Center at Camp Miakonda.

### University of Scouting (Nov. 5, 2016)

Informative (and FUN) day of required, supplemental and advanced training for adult and youth leaders involved with Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Sea Scouts and Venturing Programs.

### Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation

#### BALOO (Mar. 4, 2017)

This Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation training is required for at least one leader in the Pack in order to conduct outdoor activities. This all-day, hands-on training will provide you with the basics of what you need to know. Training to be held at Camp Miakonda.

### Outdoor Webelos Leader Skills

#### OWLS (Mar. 24-25, 2017)

This training is held in conjunction with Intro to Outdoor Leader Skills for Boy Scouts. Leaders completing this training will be trained for both Courses. While this is not required training, it is highly recommended for those Webelos Leaders wanting to take their Den camping.

### Train-the-Trainer Series

#### Fundamentals of Training (April 8, 2017)

Required training for ALL Erie Shores Training Volunteers, unless currently EDGE trained. Training is intended for both youth and adult trainers. This 4 hr. session is designed to introduce new Scouting trainers to teaching techniques and skills.

### Train-the-Trainer Series

#### Trainers EDGE (May 13, 2017)

Required training for all Erie Shores Training Event Coordinators and Wood Badge, NYLT & Summer Camp Staff. This 8 hr. course is intended to "train the trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media.
